Opener has to understand:

- The bidding message of Responder's bid
- The bidding message of Opener's rebid
- How to show the strength of the opening bid
- The best way to describe the shape of the hand it's not always obvious

There are popular bidding systems intended to make Opener's rebid more effective

This is an excellent topic for your brush up. You'll go away with five tips to make rebids by Opener and Responder more comfortable and accurate.



Day Two Five Steps to Simplify the Endplay

The Basic Idea:

- Understand what is going on in the deal
- Use the Five Steps to implement the endplay
- Recognize a suit better led by a defender –
- Improve your odds even when cards are poorly placed
- Identify the exit card to put a defender on lead – Play the exit card near the end of the deal
- Eliminate the defender's options Play trumps and side suits before the exit card
- The Throw-in: Put a defender on lead with the exit card – Play the exit card when the defender has no winning options

Even in the face of bad luck there is a way to make the contract that has fascinated bridge players for decades. While learning and practicing this specific skill, you'll notice your declarer play improves!
